▶ HERE IS WHAT YOU SHOULD KEEP IN THIS KIT:

- Flashlight
- Whistle
- Go Kit Inventory Card
- Info card and phone list
- FireSmart:LA action document
- "Okay" and "Help" sign
- Medication box



▶ ADDITIONAL THINGS TO CONSIDER:

- Additional clothes (comfy pants, underwear)
- Important documents (or legal copies)
- Toilet paper
- Blanket
- Work gloves, two pair of latex gloves
- Dust mask
- Toiletries
- Small first aid kit
- Snacks



▶ HERE IS WHAT YOU MUST INCLUDE AS WELL:

- Keys (house and car)
- Money (coins and bills)
- Comfortable shoes
- Medications (at least a one week supply)
- Glasses
- Zip lock bag



▶ YOU CAN ALSO CREATE A SEPARATE GO KIT FOR YOUR VEHICLE. IF YOU DO, INCLUDE ALL OF THE ABOVE, PLUS THESE ADDITIONAL ITEMS:

- Maps of California and surrounding areas
- Tools (screwdriver, pliers, wire, rope, bungee chords)
- Jumper cables
- Flares
- Fire extinguisher (and learn how to use it)
